## YOUNES KHOURASSANI

"It is not the light that is missing from our eyes, it is our eyes that lack light" wrote the distinguished philosopher Gustave Thibon. To find in the darkness, in the gloom, the glimmer of hope that will revive joy and optimism in the eyes of all is the intention and the will of the artist Younes Khourassani. Born in 1976 in Casablanca, Younes Khourassani has always been driven by a great creative sense.

With a solid academic background at the Casablanca School of Fine Arts, the artist has so far created along two distinctly different paths. During the first phase of his career, he devoted his work to a formal and plastic research centred his work to a formal and plastic research centred on the combination of materials (musical instruments, metals, textiles, etc.) with stormy and melancholic tones. Recently, the artist has made a radical change. At the end of a long period of global health crisis, Younes Khourassani's vision is profoundly transformed. Shaken by what this pandemic has revealed about our world, the artist proposes resolutely luminous works. Hypnotic works, with such a strong power of attraction that the viewer's gaze cannot fight and is carried away by a captivating shimmering whirlwind.

Younes Khourassani's work is unquestionably an invitation to change the prism of events and the elements that surround us, an exhortation to choose life, an injunction to always prefer the light. He presented his latest series "Sacred Light" in january 2023 at La Galerie38.
